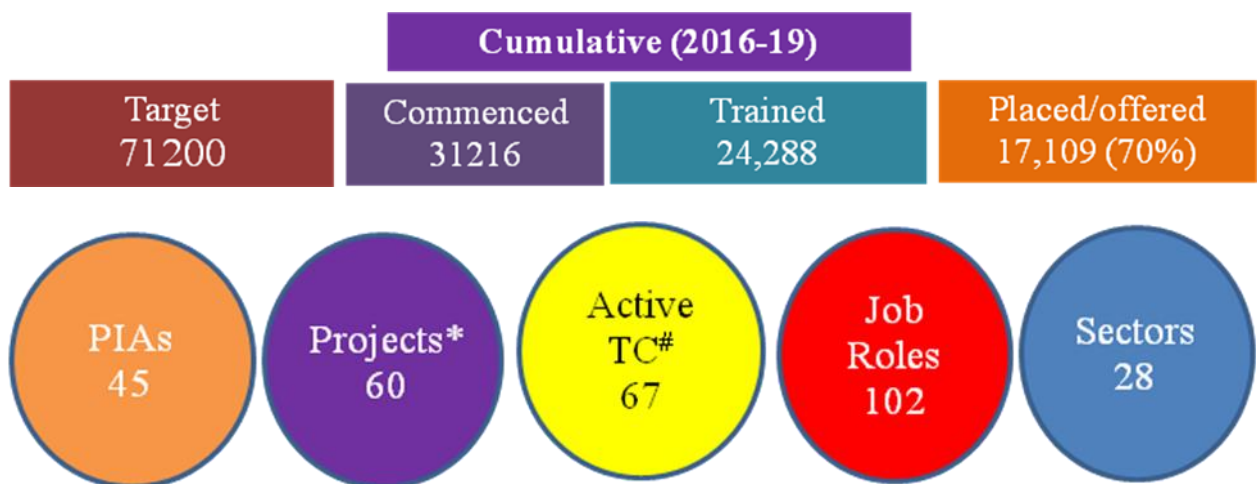


Status and achievements –DDU GKY

Achievements

- MoRD has sanctioned an additional target for the state of Kerala to provide skill training for another 20,000 youths in the state during the year 2017-19 with a financial outlay of Rs 198 crores.
